1 This matter came on for review on March 9, 2018. The Court, having considered the
2 proposed Settlement Agreement; Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs and Service
3 Awards; the points and authorities and declarations in support thereof as well as the arguments of
4 counsel; and good cause appearing, HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

5 1. The Court, for purposes of this Order, adopts the terms and definitions set forth in
6 the Settlement Agreement, as modified herein.

7 2. The Court finds that Pearson, Simon & Warshaw, LLP, Johnson & Johnson LLP,
8 Kiesel Law LLP and Boucher LLP's ("Class Counsel") lodestar, based on their historical hourly
9 rates, is \$1,136,955.28. The Court finds that this amount is reasonable based upon the amount of
10 work performed by Class Counsel. In light of the novelty and difficulty of this action; Class
11 Counsel's skill and effort in dealing with the complex issues presented by this case; and the
12 substantial benefit obtained for the Class, the Court finds that Class Counsel is entitled to a
13 lodestar multiplier of 1.47 for an award of attorneys' fees in this case of \$1,666,666.67.

14 3. The Court also finds that Class Counsel have incurred \$42,192.28 in litigation
15 costs. All of these costs were reasonably incurred in the ordinary course of prosecuting this case
16 and necessary given the complex nature and scope of the case. The Court finds that Class Counsel
17 are entitled to be reimbursed for these costs.

18 4. The Court finds that the Settlement Administrator Angeion Group may recover up
19 to \$73,757.57 in reasonable fees and costs in connection with the administration of the settlement
20 including providing notice to the class members, reviewing and processing class member claims,
21 and distributing the Settlement proceeds.

22 5. The Court further approves an incentive award of \$10,000.00 to each of the class
23 representatives, Plaintiffs Diana Tailleir, in her capacity as Trustee of the Bronson Survivors'
24 Trust, and Concourse Productions, Inc. ("Plaintiffs"). These incentive awards are justified by: (1)
25 the risks Plaintiffs faced in bringing this lawsuit, financial and otherwise; (2) the amount of time
26 and effort spent on this case by Plaintiffs; and (3) the benefits Plaintiffs helped obtain for the Class
27 Members under the Settlement Agreement.

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6. The attorneys' fees, costs and incentive awards set forth in this Order shall be paid and distributed in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
